Impact!

- Over 21,400 skilled care visits to 1,386 patients.
- Over 250 clients with Health Watch personal emergency alarms.
- Over 1300 MedBox and medication management service visits
- Over 15,000 flu immunizations for our community

IVNA provided over **one million dollars** worth of need based, uncompensated and charity care to individuals in need!

Outcomes...

★ Improved Independence for Seniors:

"IVNA helped me get the medications I needed when I could not afford them. They also gave me a button (Health Watch) that I can push if I need help." - Mary, a widow

- 69% of our clients saw an **improvement in cognitive functioning.**
- 67% of our clients saw an **improvement in light meal preparation.**
- 72% of our clients saw an **improvement in phone use.**



★ Reduced Emergency Room Visits:

".....Because of IVNA, we do not have to go to the emergency room to get care. They are our guardian angels." - Linda, a single mother of two very sick young children, who receives weekly IVNA nursing visits

- 73% of our clients **did not require emergent care** during their service period.



★ Improved the Quality of Life:

- 52% of our clients saw an **improvement in the management of oral medications.**

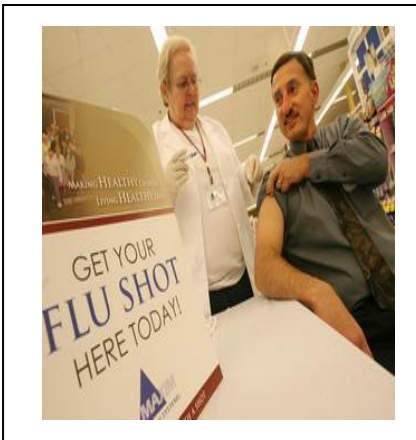
This tradition continues today...
